The Advisor Class ACTVX had a record date price of \$104.83, a reinvest price of \$99.55 and reverse share split factor of 0.94963. The Investor Class BTTRX had a record date price of \$111.95, a reinvest price of \$106.39 and reverse share split factor of 0.95033. Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per 15 share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ Immediately following the December distribution, the reverse share split was performed on 12/06/2024. The Fund's share price was raised to be the same level as before the distribution, while the share balance of each account in the Fund was reduced proportionately. To accomplish this, the reverse share split factor was calculated as follows: share price after the reverse share split divided by the share price before the reverse share split. For Advisor Class ACTVX, this would be \$99.55 divided by \$104.83, or a reverse share split factor of 0.94963. For Investor Class BTTRX, this would be \$106.39 divided by \$111.95, or a reverse share split factor of 0.95033. Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ Each time a reverse share split is performed, you are allowed to perform the reverse share split on your cost basis. For each purchase, including reinvested distributions, reduce the number of shares and increase the share price using the reverse share split factor noted previously in Section 15.
